
## CENTER FOR NETWORKED SYSTEMS **Brain-Inspired Hyperdimensional Computing for IoT Applications**





Professor Tajana Rosing has been awarded a \$500,000 National Science Foundation grant to advance hyper-dimensional computing, which seeks to process data in parallel, similar to the human brain. The hope is this approach will use less power, be more secure and generally operate more efficiently.
