#### **CNS Celebrates the Legacy of Alan Turing**

This month, we honor the birthday of the influential and iconic co-founder of computer science, Alan Turing. During World War II, Turing devised the techniques that led to breaking codes produced by Germany's Enigma machine – a breakthrough credited with accelerating the Allied victory by more than a year.

A brilliant mathematician and cryptanalyst, and despite being referred to as a national asset, Turing was persecuted in the 1950s for being gay. He took his life in 1954.

#### Scholarships in Support of LGBTQIA+ Community

In honor of Alan Turing's memory, the <u>Center for Networked Systems</u> (CNS) established the <u>Alan Turing Memorial Scholarship</u> in 2015 to encourage a more diverse and inclusive community of engineers. Since then, 11 undergraduate students in programs related to networked systems have been awarded scholarships for their achievements.

CNS is reviewing applications for the 2024-2025 scholarship and will announce recipients in the Fall.
